Sengkhw

- Zef si goar ee thaau.
(This is my head.)
- Zef si goar ee thaukhag kab
thaumngg.
(This is my head and hair.)

Sengkhw

- Zef si goar ee bin.
(This is my face.)
- Zef si goar ee bagciw, phvi kab zhuix.
(This is my eyes, nose and mouth.)

Sengkhw

- Zef si goar ee sengkhw.
(This is my body.)
- Zef si goar ee chiuo kab khaf.
(This is my hands and legs.)

Sengkhw

- Bagbaai ti bagciw ee tefngbin.
(The eyebrows are located above the eyes.)
- Zhuix ti phvi'ar ee exbin.
(The mouth is located below the nose.)

Sengkhw

- Zhuiecih ti zhuix ee laixbin.
(The tongue is inside the mouth.)
- Phvi'ar ti bin ee tiong'ngf.
(The nose is in the center of the face.)

Sengkhw

- Hvi'ar ti bin ee nngxpeeng-pvi'ar.
(The ears are on the two sides of the face.)
- Thaumngg ti tɔfui?
(Where is the hair?)

Sengkhw

- Chviafmng, lie ee zhuiekhie ti tɔfui?
(My I ask, where are your teeth?)
- Lie ee hvi'ar ti tafui?
(Where is your ears?)

Sengkhw

- Lie ee chiuo øextaxng zhoxng sviafmih?
(What can your hands do?)
- Siafji kab zørkafng.
- Goar ee chiuo øextaxng siafji kab zørkafng.
(My hands can words and work.)

Sengkhw

- Lie ee khaf øextaxng zhoxng sviafmih?
(What can your feet do?)
- Kvialo, zao kab thiaobuo.
- Goar ee khaf øextaxng kvialo.
(My feet can walk.)

Sengkhw

- Goar iong bagciw khvoax.
(I use eyes to see.)
- Goar iong phvi'ar phvixbi.
(I use nose to smell scent.)

Sengkhw

- Goar iong phvi'ar phvi phangbi iafsi zhaobi.

(I use nose to smell the fragrance or bad smell.)

- Larn iong hvi'ar thviasviaf.

(We use ears to listen the sound.)

Sengkhw

- Iong hvi'ar thviaf svia'ym ee koanke.
(Use ears to listen the high tone or low tone.)
- Larn iong zhuix ciah miqkvia.
- Larn iong zhuix korng Taigie.
(We use mouth to eat.)
