(7) Laang

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(MTLA)

Laang

- Hit'ee zapof-gyn'ar si symmih laang?
(Who is that boy?)
- Y si goar ee ahviaf (siøfti).
(He is my older brother / younger brother.)

Laang

- Hit'ee zabor-gyn'ar si symmih laang?
(Who is that girl?)
- Y si goar ee toaxcie (siøfmoe).
(She is my older sister / younger sister.)

Laang

- Lie bad hit'ee laang iar mxbad?
- Lie bad hit'ee laang'bøo?

(Do you know that person?)

- Bad, goar bad`y.
- Mxbad, goar mxbad`y.

(Yes, I know him.)

(No, I do not know him.)

Laang

- Lie bad hit'ee zabor-laang'bøo?
- Lie bad hit'ee huxjiin-laang'bøo?
(Do you know that woman?)
- Y kiørzøx symmih miaa?
(What is her name?)

Laang

- Yn si sviafmih laang?
(Who are they?)
- Yn si ang'afbor (huzhef).
(They are husband and wife.)

Laang

- Lie si Tiongkog-laang. Si`bøo?
(You are a Chinese. Right?)
- Mxsi, goar mxsi Tiongkog-laang.
- Goar si Taioaan-laang.
(No, I am not a Chinese.)
(I am a Taiwanese.)

Laang

- Chviafmng lie kuiɛsvix?
(What is your last name?)
- Goar svix Oong.
(My last name is Oong.)

Laang

- Lie si Bykog-laang. Si`bøo?
(Are you an American. Right?)
- Si, Goar si Bykog-laang.
- Mxsi, goar si Jidpurn-laang.
(Yes, I am an American.)
(No, I am a Japanese.)

Laang

- Y si cidee lauxsw.

(He is a teacher.)

- Gurn si hagsefng.

(We are students.)

Laang

- Goar mxsi y ee acie.
- Goar si y ee siøfmoe.

(I am not his older sister.)

(I am his youger sister.)

- Y si cidee Tekkog-laang.

(He is a German.)

Laang

- Yn-bor si Hoatkog-laang.
(His wife is a France.)
- Mxsi Jidpurn-laang.
(Not a Japanese.)

Laang

- Gurn tuy Taioaan laai`ee.
(We came from Taiwan.)
- Gurn lornng si Taioaan-laang.
(We are all Taiwanese.)
